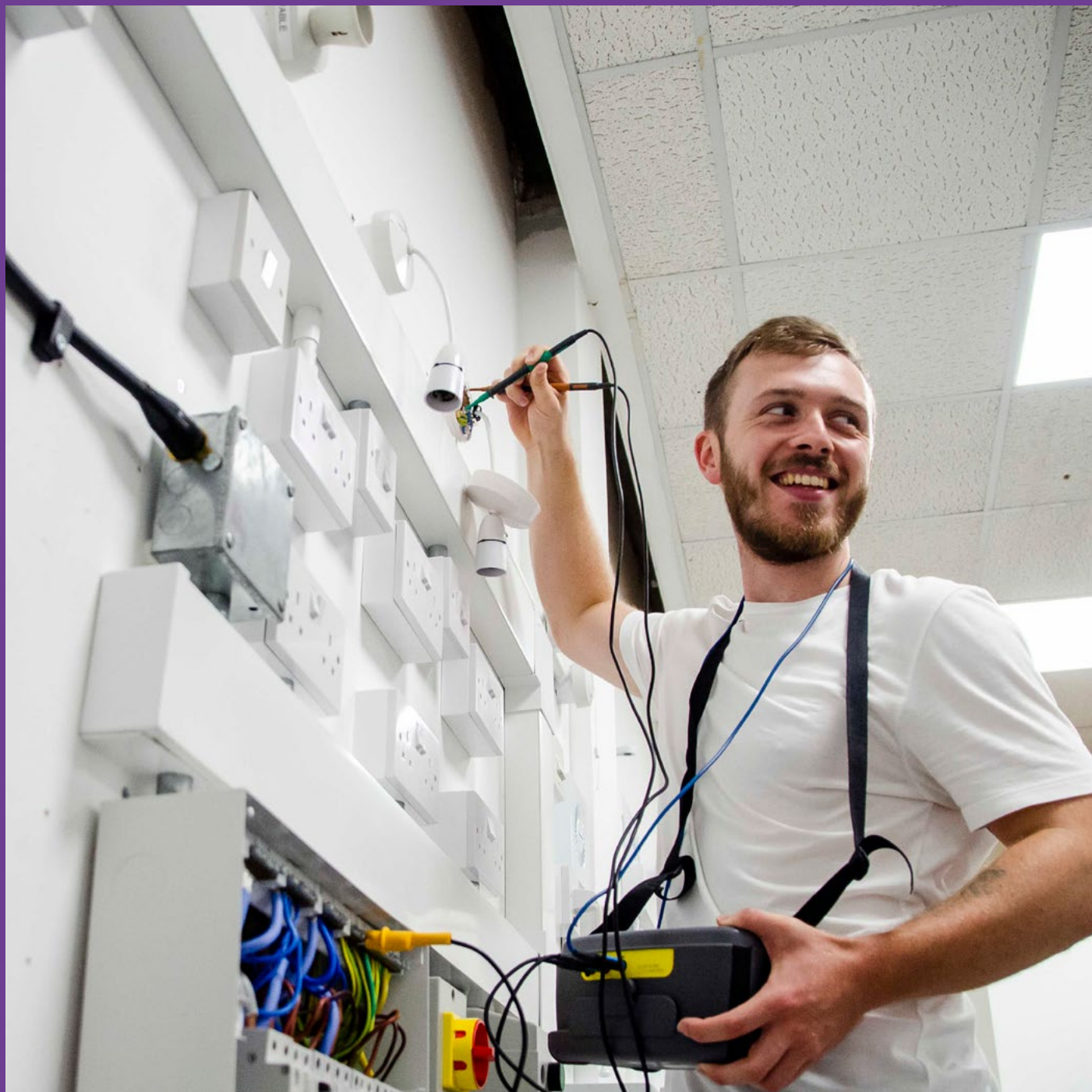



Become an Apprentice.

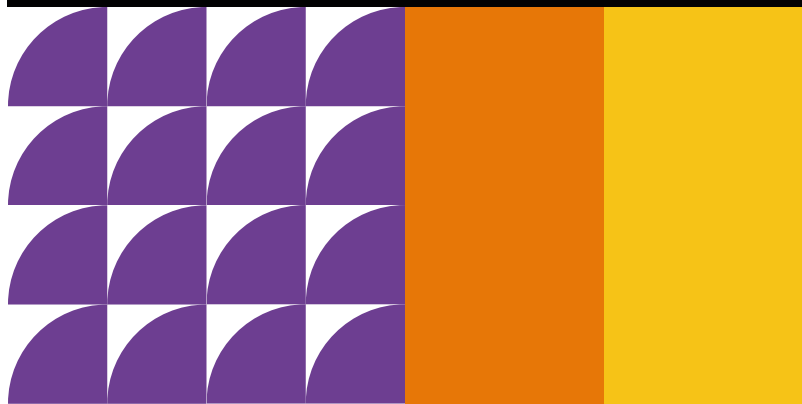
Keeping you Safe

The College has a responsibility to provide you with a safe learning environment. Learning Support

Financial Support

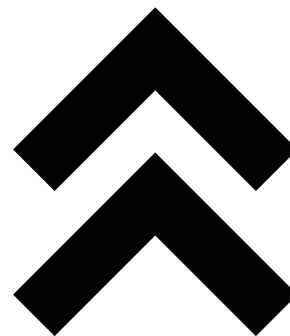
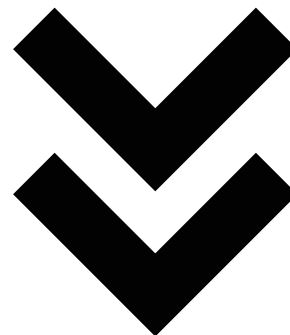


About this course
