



## 19+ Learner Support Fund Guidance 2025/26 Who can apply?

The 19+ Learner Support Fund is to support learners in full time/part time (courses must be timetabled for a minimum of 7 hours per week to qualify) further education by providing a contribution towards the cost of attending the college such as travel, uniform and childcare.

The 19+ Learner Support Fund is available to learners aged 19+ (19 as of 31<sup>st</sup> August 2025) that have an annual household income of less than £30,000.

Learners will be eligible for bursary support if they meet one of the criteria listed in the table below. The value of the award will vary depending on criteria including household income, personal circumstances and college course. Learners must maintain a minimum of 80% attendance. All awards will have a total capped amount.

For learners aged 16-18 on 31st August 2025, please refer to the 16-19 Bursary Fund Guidance.

An applicant is placed in one of the following categories based on the criteria:

## **Uniform and equipment costs**

> Uniform and equipment costs vary depending on the course and some courses have no essential costs.

## Childcare assistance

- This is only available for learners aged 20+ (20 as of 31st August 2025) that meet the criteria.
- Full time learner a maximum of £180 per week per learner.
- > Part time learner a maximum of £90 per week per learner.

## **Maintenance grant**

- This is only available to learners who meet the criteria for Learner Loan Bursary or those who qualify for Level 3 entitlement.
- Monthly maintenance award payments will be made directly to the learner's bank account each month.

For all 19+ LSF and Learner Loan Bursary recipients there is a total bursary award cap of £1000 for learners on a full-time course and £500 for learners on a part-time course.
